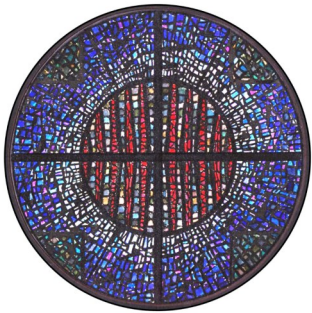

NEW CHURCH COMMUNICATION SYSTEM Church360° is our new church software that handles membership, attendance, finance, ledger, and more. It also gives us the ability to send out email and text communications, replacing our current communication system. (Emails and texts may include funeral notifications, inclement weather, or other church related information.) On Monday, October 13, members with a valid email address in our database will receive an email with information to "opt-in" to receive text messages from church. (Some members have already received this email.) Within the email you receive, there will be directions and a link to follow to enter your cell phone into the Texting Opt-In system. As a member, you are not required to "opt-in", this feature is optional. ("Opt-in" is not needed for email addresses, only cell phone numbers.)
