under one of the trees.

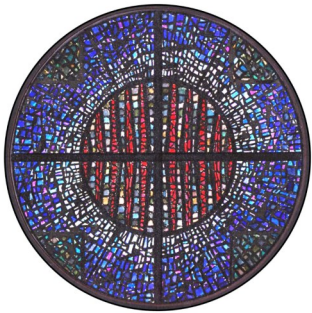
